# Scope of Voluntary National Standard of Canada (NSC)

This NSC is intended for all Animal-Assisted Human Service Providers (AAHSP) and Animal-Assisted Services Professionals (AASP), whether they be an individual or organization, for profit or not-for-profit, held publicly or privately, engaged in the business of AAHS delivery.



## NSC Guidance "Shall" vs "Should"

In this NSC, "shall" indicates that the requirement is mandatory and is supported by normative references, whereas "should" indicates that the requirement is recommended, or a best practice statement.
